“Calendar Year” Season

- Adopted by DDSL and SDFL to address unplayable pitches through winter months
- Not yet adopted by MGL
- Next full season will run from Feb/Mar '17 to Nov '17
- Break from May-Aug for U13 and above, Jul-Aug for U12 and below.
- Higher number of mid-week games in April/May and September.
- Interim/Transition/Half Season for second half of 2016

Interim Half-Season

SDFL: U15, U16, U18

- Sunday September 11th to Sunday December 11th (14 weekends)
- Full divisions (about 10 teams) – POF has details
- Selected home and away matches – no mid-week matches
- No league tables, no trophies
- Results will be used to rank teams into divisions for 2017 season

DDSL: U13, U14, U19

- Sunday September 4th to late November – 2 mid-week games in September
- Divisions split into 2 (about 5 teams each) – details on www.ddsl.ie
- No postponements - play, reverse or move midweek or 0 points to both teams.
- League tables and trophies awarded
- No promotion/relegation – full divisions again for 2017 season

- Changes in arrangements only to/from Lakelands fixtures secretaries.
- Results back to Lakelands fixtures secretaries immediately after match.
- Include any details of red cards, serious injuries, referee feedback or other issues

- Keep track of fixtures played, reversed, cancelled throughout season
- Check league results and tables on websites.
